Adapt to Cultivation in Florida

Berto Silva, a native of northeast Brasil, along the Atlantic Rainforest, is a collector of rare tropical and sub-tropical fruit trees in south Fort Myers.

He is currently experimenting with several varieties including Jua Assu (solanum sp); Biriba (rollinia deliciosa/annona deliciosa); Mangaba (hancornia speciosa var. pubescens); Jenipapo (genipa Americana); Achachairu/Bolivian Mangosteen (garcinia laterifplia/rheedia lateriflora/garcinia humilis); Mexican Garcinia (garcinia sp); Pitangatuba (Eugenia neonitida/Eugenia selloi); Grumichama (engenia brasiliensis); and many other varieties.

His presentation will focus on unusual fruits, and different varieties that adapted or may adapt to cultivation in south Florida.
